April is Safe Digging Month

Mark Dayton, Governor of Minnesota, has proclaimed the month of April 2016 as Safe Digging Month.

As stated in the April 2016 proclamation, "Each year, Minnesota's underground facilities are jeopardized by unintentional damage by those who fail to call 811 and have underground lines located prior to digging, resulting in undesired consequences including service interruption, damage to the environment, personal injury, and even death".

Gopher State One Call (GSOC) serves the citizens of Minnesota by receiving notices from home owners and professional excavators of intent to dig or excavate and notifying underground facility operators for appropriate marking of their underground facilities. Calling or clicking Gopher State One call before you dig is an important step in ensuring that you will have a safe excavation.

So, this spring, go ahead. Plan the project, call or click GSOC before your dig and enjoy the process of building the deck or planting the trees. While you admire the results of your hard work, you may also have a feeling of satisfaction that you used GSOC to keep you, your family and neighbors safe.
