What Do the Marks Mean?


The American Public Works Association (APWA) maintains a set of recommended marking guidelines to indicate infrastructural pathways of buried utilities.



ABC

Company Identifier

Name, initials, or abbreviation of the facility owner.




Line Markings

Utility identified by initials.



Clear/No Conflict


No utilities in the requested area from the identified facility.



Corridor Markings


Used to mark the width of the corridor when location is known, but number of individual lines is not.






Large Diameter Facility

For large facilities when diameter is known.




Termination Point

Dead end or stub out of a facility line.



Conduit

Width of ducts, whether single or multiple.



Offset Markings

Indicate facility owner, direction to utility and distance to facility.

APWA Uniform Color Code

Facility operators are required to mark all underground utility lines with standard color codes as established by the **American Public Works Association (APWA)**.

WHITE	Area of Proposed Excavation	ORANGE	Communication, CATV, Fiber
RED	Electric	PURPLE	Reclaimed Water, Irrigation
PINK	Temporary Survey Markings	BLUE	Water
YELLOW	Gas, Oil, Steam, Propane	GREEN	Sewer
